

2. *Alveosphaera* Jordan & Young (1990)

Derivation of name: *alveus* L. -trough

Diagnosis: *Coccosphaera fusiformis* cum *coccolithis monomorphismis*. *Coccolithi alveoformes, habens duo muri paene paralleli. Latus proximale areae centralis craticula opertum.*

Typus: *Alveosphaera bimurata* (Okada & McIntyre 1977) comb. nov.

Diagnosis: Coccusphere spindle-shaped with monomorphic coccoliths. Coccoliths are trough-shaped with two walls arranged almost parallel to each other. Proximal side of central area covered by a grill.

Type species: *Alveosphaera bimurata* (Okada & McIntyre) comb. nov.
